NEST (Nurturing and Exploring Students Talent)

Nurturing and Exploring Students Talent (NEST) is a scientifically developed educational program initiated by Team incubation to tackle and curb multifarious learning difficulties and scholastic backwardness among upper primary and high school students. NEST project was begun in Himayathul Islam Higher Secondary School at Kozhikode for upper primary students for a batch consisting of more than 36 students. The project was a significant success and we further developed to other schools. In 2016 conducted the same with 40 students in NEST child development center, Koyilandy, Calicut, and the program lasted for a period of 6 months and the same was also carried out in Keezhariyoor Govt UP School, Koyilandy, Calicut and Ansar orphanage, Areekode, Malapuram. In 2017, a 10 day NEST camp was conducted in Koduvally lower primary school for 60 students, in the initial four months of 2018 also continued the project with 175 students. The remediation stage of NEST project will enable at risk students to improve their reading and writing skills through utilization of our particular method equipped with well trained trainers and academic tutors. Students undergone this innovative learning system will be able to utilize all their classroom materials, including textbooks providing them access to the general curriculum. The students will increase their reading speed, comprehension, and writing skills which will help them obtain classroom subject proficiency.

TOP (Teen's Outreach Programme)

TOP (Teen's outreach programme) is one of the effective programmes by Team incubation conducted for SSLC students. This programme aims at improving both academic and extracurricular skills of students through proper methodologies. The faculties of the programme would be the skilled professional and trainers from different streams like Psychology, Education etc.,

This one year programme (July- April) will help encourage students in their studies. It also make the students fully prepared for their SSLC exams. The course ends with a camp after SSLC examination.

AIMS

- To ensure 100% result in SSLC examination.
 - To improve the academic level of the students according to their potential and give them the best results in examination.
 - To find the pitfalls in learning and to help them in overcoming it.
 - To improve the life skills that will help them in their personnel and social enhancement.
 - To inculcate the creativity among students which would make them unique?
 - To find and cope with the individual and behavioral problems among the students.
- To assist the students to find their aptitude and help them in ensuring the wholesome growth of the students.

PEPP (Premier Entrance Preparation Programme)

Academic exposure and frequent follow up as well as practice and revision is just some of the services provided by PEPP. Path Finder

India's higher education system is the third largest in the world next to the United States and China. Indian higher education system has expanded at a fast pace by adding nearly 20000 colleges and more than 8 million students in a decade from 2000-01 to 2010-11. As of 2011 India has 42 central universities, 275 state universities, 130 deemed universities, 90 private universities, 5 institutions established and functioning under the state act, and 93 institutions of national importance which includes IITs, AIIMs, NITs, among others. Some institution of India, such as the IITs, IIMs, and Jawaharlal Nehru University has been globally acclaimed for their standard of education. Even though Kerala possess a number of academically excellent people they don't catch up to the pioneering institutions. And the major reason behind that is the lack of awareness. They consider these institutions as an unreachable goal and 'pathfinder' acts as a tool to unveil the veil of unawareness. An institution has an inevitable role in moulding a student. Alchemy mainly concentrates in career orientation and occupational awareness for the young graduates. Alchemy is designed to provide students with a realistic picture of themselves and it emphasize the decision-making process of their own future. Through Alchemy, we impart information's from a variety of sources such as audio- visual aids, PPT presentations, resource speakers, lectures and open discussions. Through this programme various personalities from divergent fields interact with a selected audience. The expert faculty delivers a lecture for an hour followed by a discussion. The faculties of the I Talk would be the skilled professional and trainers from different streams with an inspiring background.

Happy Connect

Internet is the technology that has revolutionized human lives for the past decade. It has also provided a multitude of opportunities in educational field. At the same time internet is a double edged sword with constructive and destructive aspects. It is very important to focus our children towards the positive side of internet. Happy Connect aims at guiding children towards the constructive side of internet. Through this outreach program, team incubation aims to provide awareness about various digital platforms to childrens for their better understanding of the technology and knowledge.

Let Them Fly

On the backdrop of various sexual harassment cases reported across India, there have been wide spread protests and anger amongst the public all over India. Our Team believes that social networking sites can be used as an important medium for the first level response of any issue. But there should be a second and third level responses too that will reach society level and produces long lasting impacts. Let her fly aims to fill this vacuum and to reduce the number of child abuse cases in India. Let her fly project aims to find a solution to this unending panacea in our society through our modules, camps, and gender sensitization.

Wear Blue Campaign

'Wear Blue' was an autism awareness campaign organized by Incubation with the support of Eden Child Development Centre at Calicut city on 1st April 2018. Recent research proved that as many as 20% of children with autism have been formally excluded from education in the past 12 months. That means that one in five children aren't getting the education that every child should be entitled to. The campaign was to ensure that no child is ruled out because they have autism. Decathlon Calicut, CRC, Hilite Mall, UF Club were also part of the campaign. Autism Walk, Cyclothon, Sports and Games for Autistic students, Mall Events, Painting Competition etc were organized as part of the campaign. Sports and Games for the autistic persons were held at Decathlon sports centre, Calicut. Around 50 students participated in various sports and games. Dr. MK Muneer MLA inaugurated the program. Cyclothon started from Decathlon and finished at Calicut Beach. MP Jayaraj (Legal Service Authority) inaugurated the valedictory session. The Wear Blue campaign marked the importance of giving awareness to people about the autism. Today, 1 in 68 children is diagnosed, a nearly 30% increase in three years. Despite this high prevalence, research shows that many parents of young children have very little knowledge about the signs of autism and are not seeking help early enough. While there is currently no cure for autism, early detection and intervention can result in critical improvements across the lifespan.

Together We Can

In August 2018, severe flooding and landslides hit across Kerala. It was the worst flood since 1924. Many people lost their lives and many were displaced. As an NGO, working in the educational sector, Incubation initiated a campaign 'Together We Can' to help students in the flood hit areas. The idea of relief came from the students of Ansar Orphanage, Kizhissery. The campaign focused on preparing handwritten notebooks and other necessary school materials for the students. The 100-odd children in the orphanage sat down to copy by hand some 500 notebooks of social studies, science, English, Malayalam and Hindi from class 5 to 10 of the Kerala State school syllabus. Incubation volunteers scanned the best-written notes, turned them into PDF files and e-mailed to all those who had offered to help out. In less than two weeks, 10,000 handwritten notebooks arrived from Delhi, Pune, Chennai, Mumbai and other cities as well as from within Kerala.

This way the children would know who had helped them in their hour of need and instill a sense of responsibility, gratitude, and affection in them. On August 30, some 10,000 handwritten notebooks so copied were handed over to district education officials in Alappuzha and Wayanad, two of the worst flood-affected districts. In a week's time, many of the children who lost their class notes to the surging waters will have in their hands notes written with care and love.

Happy Reading Campaign

Persons with visual impairments cannot read the standard print. They need the reading material (text books, magazines, newspapers etc.) in alternative accessible formats like Braille, audio book, large print or accessible eBook. 'Happy Reading Campaign' organized by Team Incubation with the support of Ability Centre, Pulikkal, Malappuram to support the digital talking library. 'Urava' Audio library is the library started by Ability Centre to help the visually impaired students. The library is recognized by District Library Council. The Campaign started in September 2018 and finished in November 2018. More than 400 people across Kerala participated in the campaign. The campaign posters were posted through different social media platforms and e books were distributed through whatsapp. Students, teachers, homemakers etc.. actively participated in the campaign. The recorded audio files were uploaded through the Google drive. Emergence of new alternative format like DAISY holds lot of promise for the print impaired community (anyone who cannot read standard print). Since these are digital books they are easy to duplicate and transmit. These formats contain features that provide a pleasant reading experience to people with print impairments. These formats have support for integrated audio, magnification, text-to-speech, image descriptions and much more.
